<u>NAGT SCHOLARSHIPS FOR FIELD STUDY</u>	02/14/13	\$500	The NAGT Scholarships for Field Study are meant to support students' participation in intensive field courses in any aspects of geoscience that focus on students practicing skills of field observation, data collection, analysis and synthesis. Awardees are selected based on the importance of the field experience in meeting their educational and career goals and of the financial award in allowing them to participate in the program.
